An ordinance levying taxes for all town purposes for West Deerfield Township,
Lake County, Illinois, for the tax year 2025 , collectable in 2026.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of West Deerfield Township,
Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the sum of one million seventy four thousand two hundred forty six
Dollars (\$ 1,074,246) are hereby levied upon all
property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to
meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Township as required by statute or voted
by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:






SECTION 5: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.



TRUTH IN TAXATION
CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE
(35 ILCS 200/18-90)

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of West Deerfield Township, (Legal Name of Taxing District), and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.
